

Additional financial and contractual flexibilities for ongoing projects of the international pilot programme 2018-2020

(published 10 February 2022)

These provisions only apply when your project is affected due to the COVID-19 situation.

The provisions provide for the following exceptional regulations for international pilot programme projects:

- Projects can be **extended for a maximum of 24 months**. However, the budget will not be increased. Please contact Movetia for this purpose.
- Transnational activities can take place virtually – providing they are helpful.
- In principle and on request, the **funds committed under contract (particularly mobility funds)** can be transferred and spent on other actions/activities. The contractually agreed aims according to the proposal must remain the same. If adjustments are necessary, these must be discussed with and confirmed by Movetia.
- The principle of force majeure applies to all mobility projects that have been cancelled or interrupted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. - If you have the relevant receipts, you can include cancellation costs in the final invoice, provided your budget allows it. The contractual requirement remains that once the maximum funding amount per project has been reached, no further funding can be granted by Movetia. The final report must **clearly and transparently show** what the transferred funds were used for.
- It is best to contact Movetia in good time to **clarify the eligibility of any transfers in advance**.
